A Vision Transformed Into Reality

ENLACE's experience in the Abelines region illustrates that our methodology is working and radical church-based community transformation is possible.

It's in the Numbers...

- **10** Churches working in community transformation efforts
- **32% to 14%** Decline in unsafe housing rate
- **47 to 2 per 1000** Decrease in infant mortality rate
- **33% to 93%** Access and use of latrines
- **0% to 95%** Access to electricity
- **1% to 79%** Access to clean water



Reina Membreño de Amaya was one of the founding members of the Health Committee in Abelines. Her daughter, Melvin Yamileth, died from a severe parasitic infection at age two, but now access to clean water and sanitation facilities, along with preventive health education, have resulted in a healthier life for Reina and her family.

Investing in the Vision

*In 2011 ENLACE aims to work with **45** churches implementing **75** life-changing initiatives that will impact more than **55,000** people. However, we still need to raise more than **\$100,000** this year to meet the growing opportunities.*
