Dear ENLACE Partner,

God continues to prepare and position ENLACE strategically to resource local churches to transform their communities. In 2009, your generous contributions helped us to continue to equip the churches we are currently committed to and take on a record-breaking number of new local church partners. Our 26 local church partners worked with their communities to implement 33 initiatives which directly impacted more than 20,000 people. Additionally, the number of interested church partners has never been greater. For the first time in our history, we have a waiting list of over 50 churches wanting to partner with us.

We are running into 2010 excited to see what God will do. We have the capacity to partner with 10 additional churches which will take us to a total of 36 local partners. These partners have already identified and/or are working with over 44 projects which will directly impact the lives of over 40,000 people. 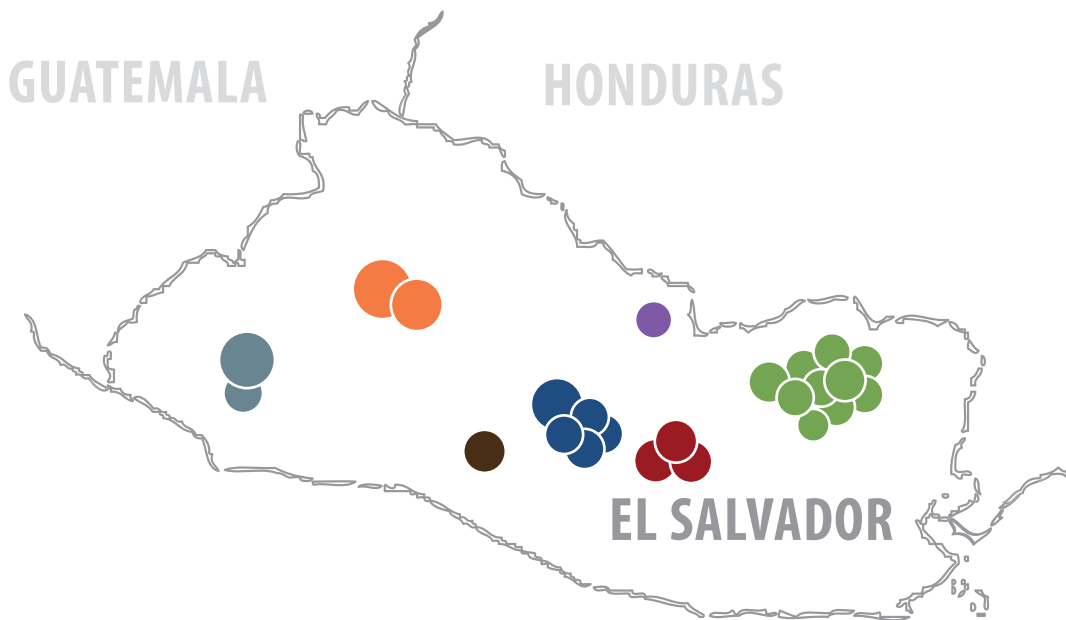

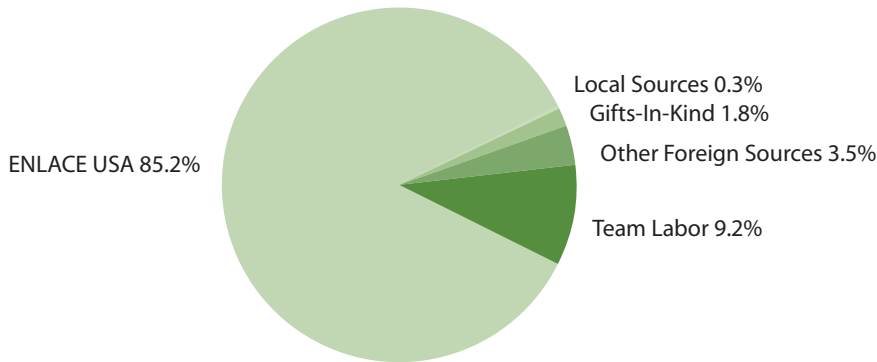

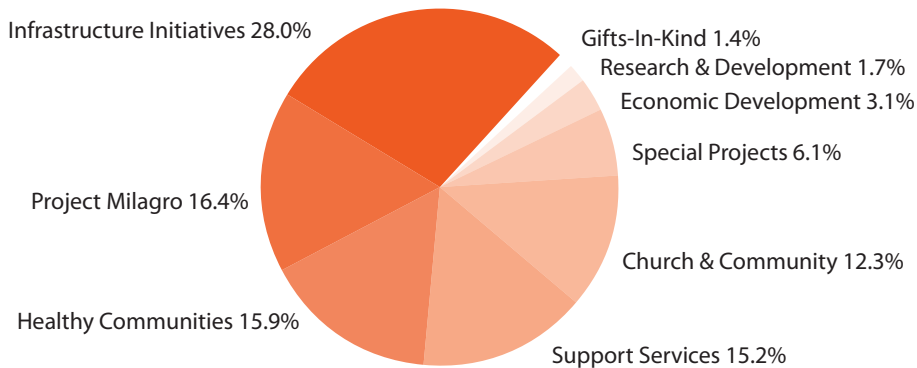
